

Registering for the SAT and ACT

(Menwith Hill's School Code is 724310 for both the ACT and SAT.)

- **Please note that you must use the codes we provide for both the school and test center, as military base names are “hidden” on the website since they have restrictions on who may test at these centers.**
- **Be sure to print out your admission ticket and take it with you to the test.**

ACT: Students register for the ACT online at www.act.org. Menwith Hill School's testing center code for the ACT is **870090**. The ACT costs \$31.00 (or \$46 if you take the ACT Plus Writing which is available at the October and December test). Students who attend DoDEA schools outside the US do not have to pay the \$25.00 overseas surcharge. The surcharge waiver numbers are serialized, so students must get their individual waiver number from the counselor, Dr. Gunderson. Testing is usually from 8:00 a.m. (arrive at 7:45 a.m.) – 11:45 a.m. on Saturdays.

SAT: Students register for the SAT online at www.collegeboard.com. Menwith Hill School's testing center code for the SAT is **57154**. The SAT Reasoning Test costs \$45.00. (Students who are interested in taking the SAT Subject test, which focuses on a specific subject should see Dr. Gunderson.) When filling out their personal profile, students should use their PSC address, and use the state designation of “American Forces in Canada, Europe, etc.” Before students select their school and test center, there is a bubble that must be marked indicating that we are “outside the U.S.”. Testing is usually from 8:00 a.m. (arrive at 7:45 a.m.) – 12:30 p.m. on Saturdays.

Students should get a good night's sleep before test day, and eat a healthy breakfast. They should arrive at Menwith Hill School at 7:45 a.m., and should bring their admission ticket, government-issued ID, two number two pencils, an approved calculator, a watch to keep an eye on the time, and, if they like, snacks to be eaten during breaks.
